Dog licenses need to be renewed every two years (current period is January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2010) and should be purchased by January 1.

For new residents and newly acquired dogs: New residents of White Bear Lake must license their dog within 60 days. Newly acquired dogs must be licensed within 60 days or within 6 months of age, whichever comes first. If you are a new resident obtaining a license during the second year of a two-year license period, the price is prorated and reduced by 50 percent. If you are obtaining a license for a newly acquired dog during the second year of a two-year license period, the price is prorated and reduced by 50 percent.

You may purchase your license by mail or in person at the White Bear Lake City Hall Information Desk or License Bureau, 4701 Highway 61. **Proof of rabies vaccination must be provided.** If you mail in the application and payment, a copy of the rabies vaccination certificate must be included. Upon receipt of your application, payment and rabies vaccination certificate, the dog license and tag will be mailed to you.
